Meets the specification for UK bread making and ukp for export



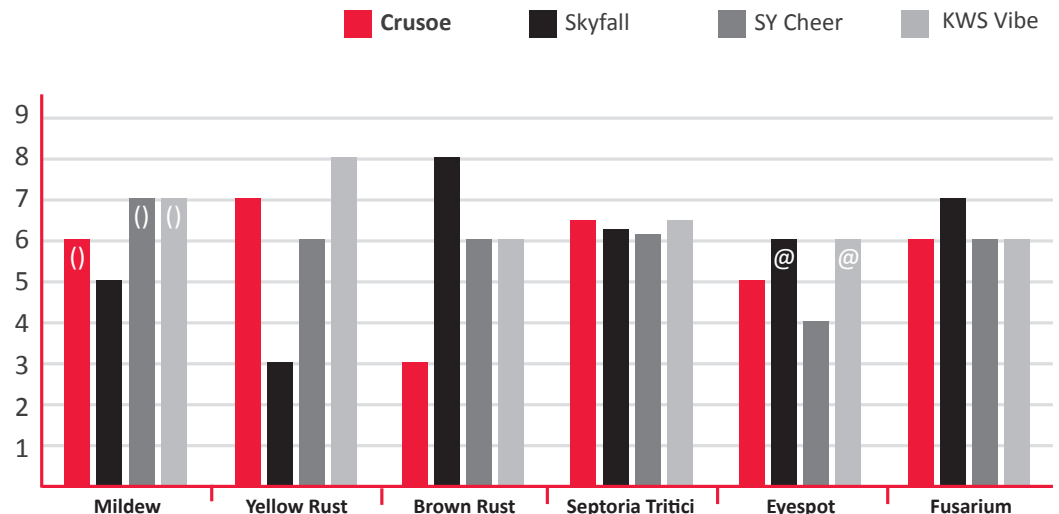

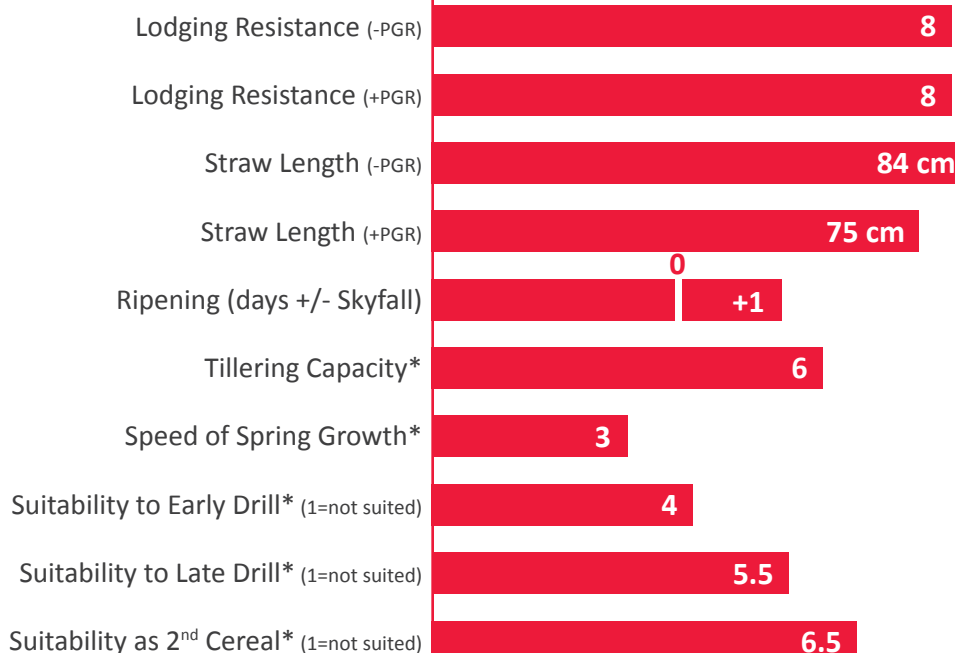

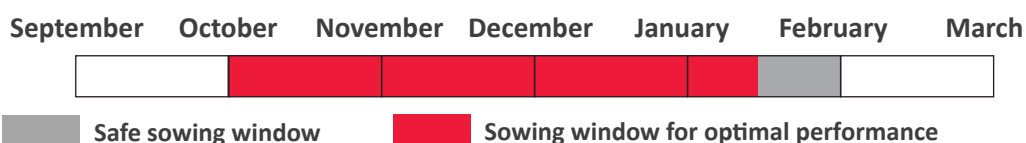
